This CSR Annual Action Plan for FY 2025-26, for the CSR Budgeted amount of Rs. 222.36 Lakhs, is formulated in pursuance of the CSR Policy and is approved by the Board, based on the recommendations of the CSR Committee of the Company.

Provided that the Board may alter such CSR Annual Action Plan for FY 2025-26 at any time during the Financial Year, as per the recommendation of its CSR Committee, based on the reasonable justification to that effect.

MANNER OF EXECUTION OF SUCH PROJECTS OR PROGRAMMES AS SPECIFIED IN RULE 4 (1) OF THE RULES:

The CSR projects/programs shall be implemented by MCSL either directly or through Muthoot Pappachan Foundation/other implementing agencies/in collaboration with other non-profit organisations. The duration of the project or program will be related to the nature of that project or program and its impact on society.

The programs may be implemented in collaboration with specialized organizations which include, but is not limited to Muthoot Pappachan Foundation, like Indian Medical Association, Red Cross, Aashiana Trust, Smile Please, Guardian of dreams, Rajagiri, and other partnering hospitals.

The Company may undertake CSR activities other than the activities mentioned, in line with the rules/ circulars/ amendments framed therein or as modified from time to time by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs and as approved by the Board, based on the recommendations of the CSR Committee, including any CSR activities or expenditure permitted to be undertaken under or pursuant to any scheme, program, or initiative introduced by the Central or State Government towards social and economic betterment. Preference will be given to the local communities / areas where the Company's facilities are situated.

MODALITIES OF UTILISATION OF FUNDS AND IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULES FOR THE PROJECTS OR PROGRAMMES:

The entire budgeted amount of ₹ 222.36 Lakhs for the FY 2025-26 (not be less than 2% of the average net profits of the Company during the three immediately preceding financial years) as approved by the Board, based on the recommendation of the CSR Committee, shall be spent for one or more of the approved CSR projects or programs as mentioned in this Annual Action Plan.

Any unspent CSR amount or excess spent CSR amount shall be dealt with as provided in sub-section (5) & (6) of section 135 of the Companies Act 2013, read with the Companies (Corporate Social Responsibility) Rules, 2014 and Schedule VII to the Companies Act, 2013, as amended from time to time.

Implementation schedule: The entire budgeted amount of ₹ 222.36 Lakhs for the FY 2025-26 as approved by the Board based on the recommendation of the CSR Committee shall be endeavoured to spent in the Financial Year 2025-26 and if the Company fails to spend such amount, the Board shall, in its report made under clause (o) of sub-section (3) of Section 134 of the Act, specify the reasons for not spending the amount.

MONITORING AND REPORTING MECHANISM FOR THE PROJECTS OR PROGRAMMES:

The Monitoring Mechanism for each project will differ on the basis of the nature of the project. All the projects will be monitored & evaluated as per the objectives & deliverables set for respective projects as per Board & CSR Committee recommendation.

REPORTING MECHANISM

CSR Committee

The CSR Committee oversees the implementation of the CSR policy of the company in accordance with the requirements of Section 135 of the Companies Act.

An annual report on CSR with such information and particulars as may be required by the Act shall be prepared by Management and such report shall be approved by the CSR Committee and included in the Board's report annexed to the financial statements.

Board's responsibility

The Board will be responsible for ensuring that the statutory requirements as may be prescribed from time to time under the Act and the CSR Rules are complied with.

The Board shall ensure that the funds so disbursed have been utilized for the purposes and in the manner as approved by it. Further, the Chief Financial Officer of the Company shall certify to that effect on a quarterly basis and submit a utilization certificate with the statement that the funds so disbursed have been utilized for the purposes and in the manner as approved by the Board, based on the recommendations of the CSR committee.

The Board shall ensure that the administrative overheads shall not exceed five percent of the total CSR expenditure of the company for the financial year.

DETAILS OF NEED AND IMPACT ASSESSMENT, IF ANY, FOR THE PROJECTS UNDERTAKEN BY THE COMPANY:

MCSL does not have an average CSR obligation of ten crore rupees or more in pursuance of subsection (5) of section 135 of the Act, in the three immediately preceding financial years or CSR projects having outlays of one crore rupees or more, therefore the same is not applicable. However, if any project with an outlay of one crore rupees or more is initiated by the Company, the need and impact assessment shall be duly undertaken at that point of time.
